

# Connecting to the Mobile E-Catalog

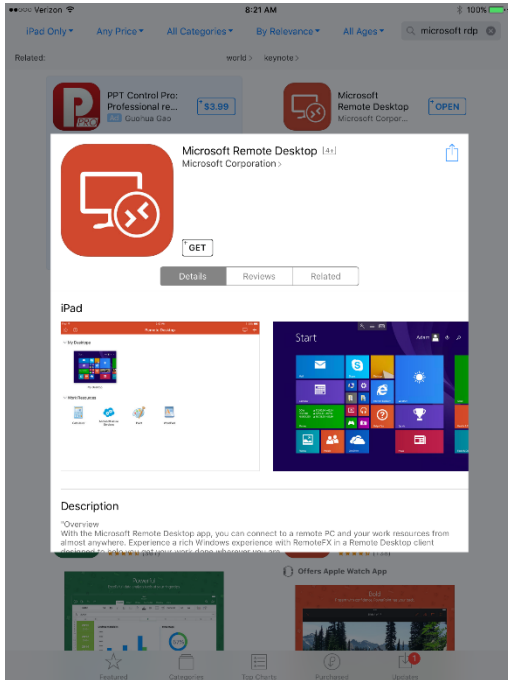
## Badger

An RDP client is required for mobile users using either Apple or Android. Microsoft Remote Desktop is the recommended RDP - it is a free client application that is available for most mobile devices. An RDP client should also be used when connecting from an Apple or Linux desktop. Microsoft Remote Desktop is available for Apple users and Linux users should use Remmina or FreeRDP.

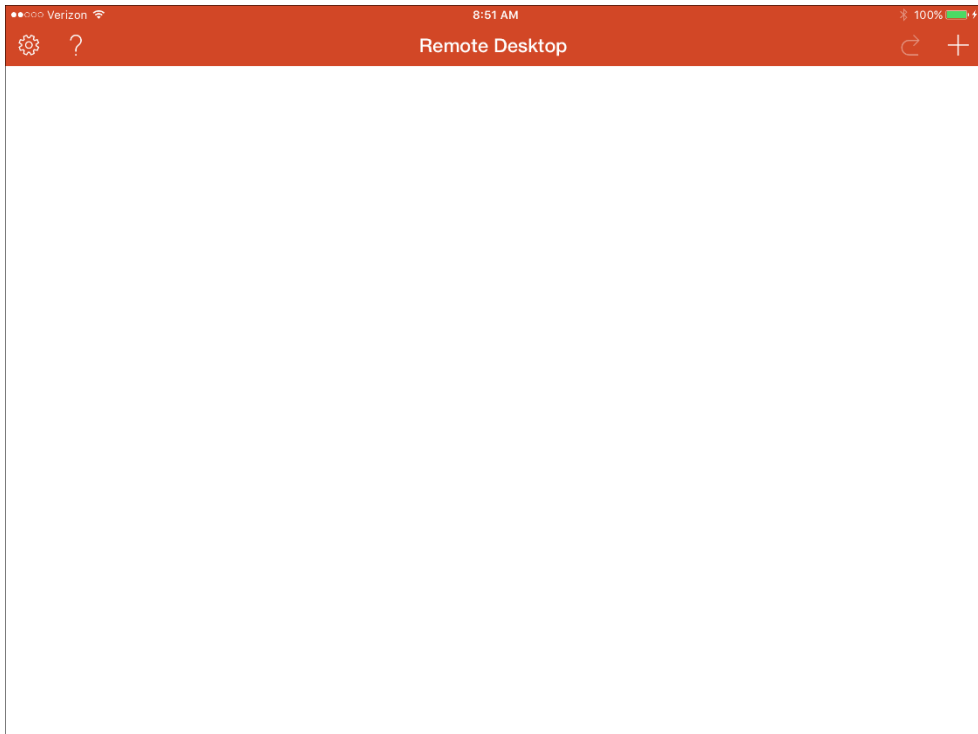
## Microsoft Remote Desktop Installation and Setup

Install the application on the mobile device and setup the connection as shown in the following images. Depending on the device and operating system, the setup page may have a slightly different appearance.

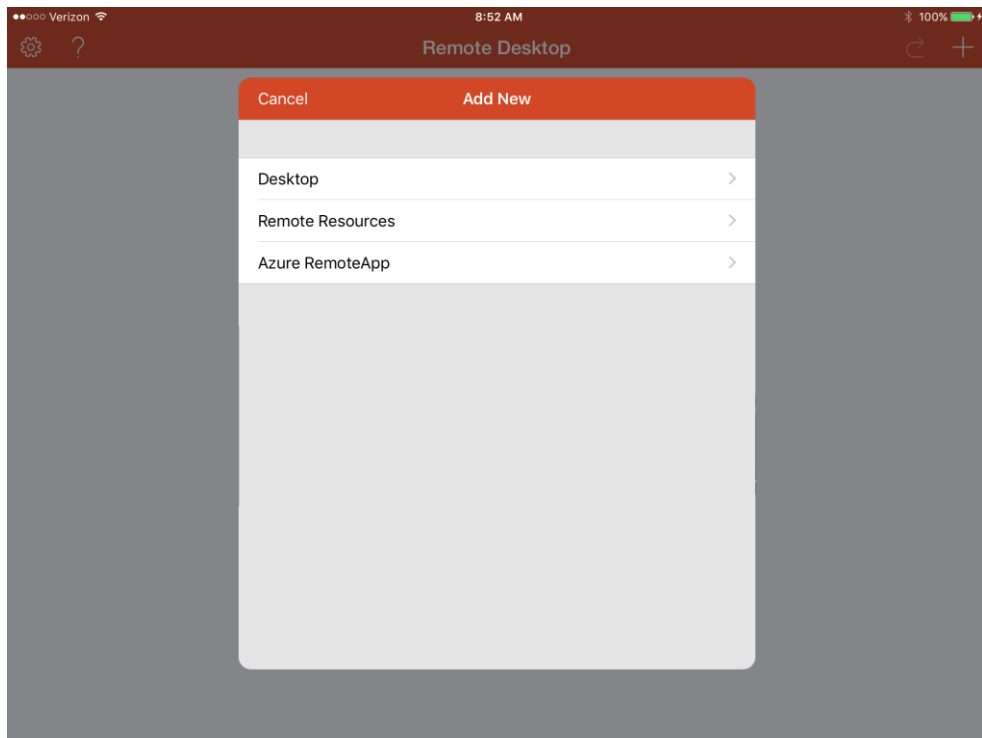
# Begin by installing Microsoft Remote Desktop from the App Store



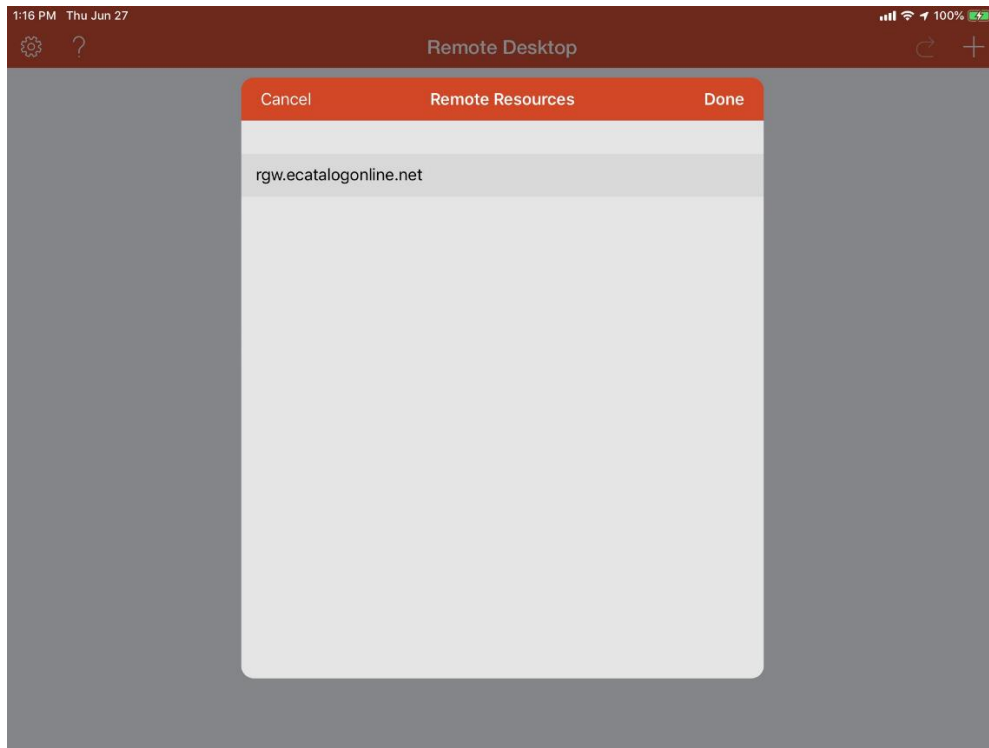
Once the download is complete, launch the app and select the + button on top toolbar to configure a new Remote Desktop



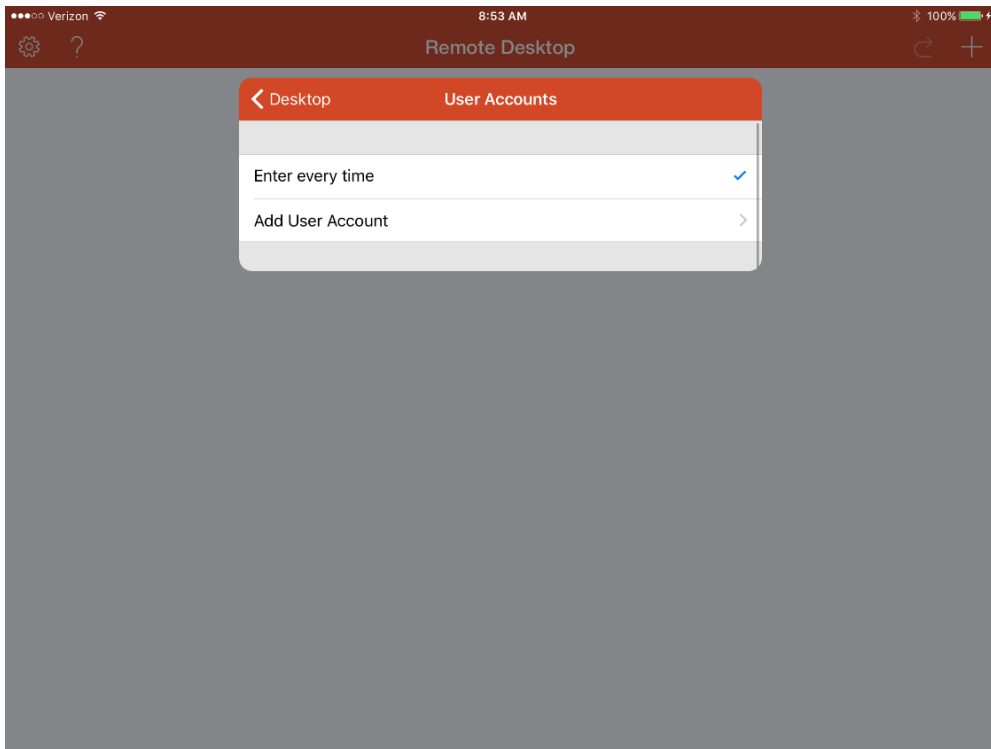
## Select Remote Resources



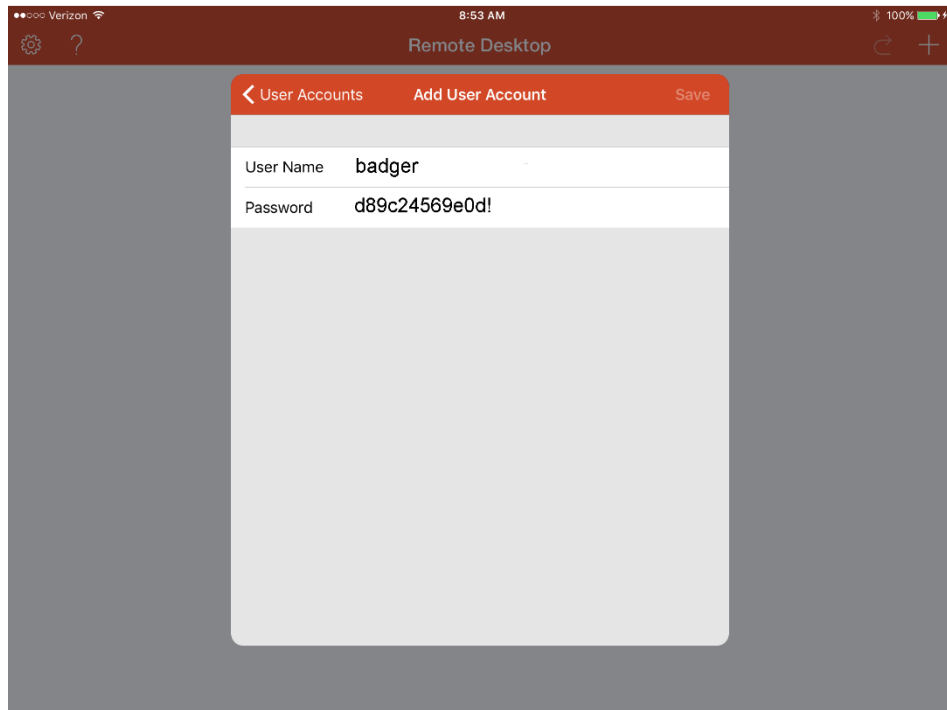
Enter rgw.ecatalogonline.net in the PC Name Field and select User Account



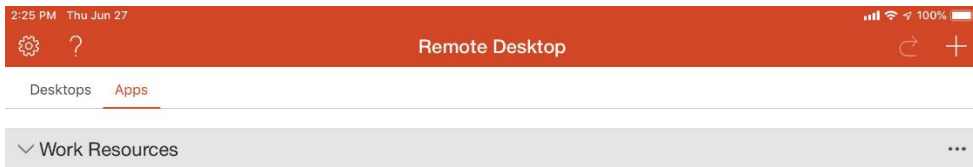
## Select Add User Account
