

Connecting to the Online E-Catalog

The online E-Catalog can be accessed in a variety of ways and the optimal method will depend on both the device and the operating system in use. Explanations and examples of the various options available for launching the E-Catalog are provided below as well as general information on when each option is applicable.

E-Catalog Auto Launcher

The E-Catalog Auto Launcher can be downloaded and installed from:

Auto Launcher will work for any computer with Windows 8 (or later).

Auto Launcher potentially may not be compatible with Windows 7, Windows, XP, and Windows Vista. In the event an issue occurs no support will be available for these platforms due to the required updates for these systems being no longer available. If a user is up to date with Windows updates, they may be able to use the Auto Launcher.

E-Catalog Quick Access

Some users may not be able to download or install either of the desktop launching applications. The computer in use may have restrictions on downloads, installations or the use of Remote Desktop Programs (RDP). In this case, the E-Catalog can be launched directly from their browser using E-Catalog Quick Access. E-Catalog Quick Access can be launched from the following URL:

The Quick Access program has limitations when compared to the other versions. Because connection occurs via a web page and not through the Remote Desktop protocol, users will not have access to their hard drives or printers. When printing, a PDF file is downloaded to the computer and the user must then open and print or email the downloaded PDF. The Quick Access version is not recommended for mobile devices as the on-board keyboard support is currently under development.
